

ART CAMP 2018 (International Summer School of Art)

Term: 9th July – 27th July 2018 (3 weeks)

University: Ladislav Sutnar Faculty of Design and Art of the University of West Bohemia

City: Pilsen, Czech Republic

Participants: 10 – 15 students and professors from National Taiwan University of Arts from Taipei, Tschaj-wan guests can come in one term or in different dates because ArtCamp has 1-week courses during 3 weeks <https://fdu.zcu.cz/en/415-artcamp-about>

Trainings will be held in the studios of the Ladislav Sutnar Faculty of Design and Art (located at the campus of the University of West Bohemia, Univerzitní 28, Pilsen) or in the open air.

Tuition takes place Monday to Friday usually 8 teaching hours (45 mins each) a day (tuition and individual work) at small group of students (10 – 15 participants):

09 a.m. - 12 p.m. / work

12 p.m. - 01 p.m. / lunch break

01 p.m. - 04 p.m. / work


04 p.m. – 06 p.m. / afternoon programme

Each Friday afternoon (2 – 3 p.m.) a short presentation of the results of work will take place in the studios. After this presentation the participants will receive their Certificate of Attendance.

Price: free of charge (LSFDA can offer courses free of charge, standard price per 1 participant is approx. 200 EUR)

Description: The ArtCamp consists of almost 35 art workshops and approximately 450 participants visit every year from all over the world as it is the biggest Art Summer School in Central Europe. LSFDA would like to invite lecturers and students from Taiwanese art schools (National Taiwan University of Arts) to take part in ArtCamp workshops. It would be beneficial if Taiwanese professors could participate as lecturers in some of the workshops. ArtCamp is an excellent way to bridge our ties closer together; for closer cooperation, new ideas, cultural exchange and as a platform for future international projects. Incoming Taiwanese Students and professors under the project would have free admission for ArtCamp workshops.

If it is not possible to arrange for a visit by the Taiwanese delegation to the ArtCamp, workshops can also take place during October - November 2018, when LSFDA has a semester lessons.
